BY-LAW NO. 26

A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF MIRAMICHI RESPECTING VOLUNTARY PENALTIES

The Council of the City of Miramichi, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any By-Law of the City of Miramichi, any Police Officer of the said City may at any time before the institution of proceedings against a person for any violation of any City By-Law, accept from such person alleged to have been guilty of such violation, the payment of a sum equal to the minimum penalty prescribed for such violation, and such payment shall constitute full satisfaction and discharge of all penalties incurred by such violation.
- 2. All payments hereunder shall be transmitted by the person receiving the same to the City Treasurer of the City of Miramichi.
- 3. This By-Law will repeal the following By-Laws:
 - 1. By-Law No. 98, "A By-Law Respecting Voluntary Penalties" ,Former Town of Chatham, enacted December 12, 1984; and
 - 2. By-Law No. 24, "A By-Law to Regulate the Recovery of Penalties", Former Town of Newcastle.
- 4. This By-Law shall come into effect on the date of final reading and enactment thereof.
