

BY-LAW NO. 16

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF MIRAMICHI
WITH RESPECT TO THE LAYING OF INFORMATIONS**

1. In this By-Law,
 - (a) "By-Law" means a By-Law of the City of Miramichi;
 - (b) "Chief of Police" means the Chief of Police of the City of Miramichi Police Force, and includes the Deputy-Chief of Police of the City.
 - (c) "Council" means the Council of the City of Miramichi.
 - (d) "City" means the City of Miramichi.
2. Pursuant to Section 101 of Chapter M-22 of the Municipalities Act, R.S.N.B., 1973, Chap. M-22, the Council of the City of Miramichi designates the Chief of Police, Deputy Chief of Police, and members of the City of Miramichi Police Force, as persons to lay any Information before any Court for a breach of any of the By-Laws of the Municipality of Miramichi.
3. This By-Law repeals the following By-Law:
 - i) By-Law No. 55, "A By-Law of the Former Town of Chatham With Respect to the Laying of Informations", enacted February 12, 1979; and all amendments thereto.
4. This By-Law shall come into effect on the date of the final reading by title and the enacting thereof.
