

BY-LAW NO. 48

A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF MIRAMICHI TO REPEAL CERTAIN BY-LAWS

The Council of the Municipality of Miramichi, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The following By-Laws of the former Town of Chatham are hereby repealed:
 - i) By-Law No. 14, A By-Law Respecting Fire Crackers, Spring Guns & Air Rifles, enacted May 12, 1969 and all amendments thereto;
 - ii) By-Law No. 15, A By-Law To Regulate and License Exhibition of Natural or Artificial Curiosity, Circuses and Other Shows and Exhibitions For Hire or Profit, enacted May 12, 1969 and all amendments thereto;
 - iii) By-Law No. 21, A By-Law To Approve Contract Between Her Majesty the Queen and the Town of Chatham and the Town of Newcastle, enacted March 21, 1972 and all amendments thereto;
 - iv) By-Law No. 46, A By-Law Respecting the Chatham Recreation and Parks Commission, enacted November 10, 1977;
 - v) By-Law No. 78, A By-Law Respecting the Chatham Recreation and Parks Advisory Commission, enacted January 12, 1981 and all amendments thereto;
 - vi) By-Law No. 98, A By-Law Respecting Voluntary Penalties, enacted December 12, 1984 and all amendments thereto; and
 - vii) By-Law No. 155, A By-Law Respecting the Police Force of the Town of Chatham, enacted February 11, 1991 and all amendments thereto.

2. The following By-Laws of the former Town of Newcastle are hereby repealed:
 - i) By-Law No. 3, A By-Law To Regulate & License Exhibition Shows, Theatrical Performances, Concerts, Circuses, and Other Entertainment, enacted April 17, 1969 and all amendments thereto;
 - ii) By-Law No. 9, A By-Law to Regulate the Newcastle Town Dump, enacted May 2, 1968;
 - iii) By-Law No. 11, Auctioneers and Auction Sales
 - iv) By-Law No. 17, A By-Law for the Protection of Property, enacted December 16, 1965;
 - v) By-Law No. 24, A By-Law To Regulate the Recovery of Penalties, enacted December 16, 1965;
 - vi) By-Law No. 26, A By-Law To License Dealers in Salvage and Second Hand Goods, enacted December 16, 1965;
 - vii) By-Law No. 27, A By-Law Respecting Evening Curfew for Minors, enacted February 20, 1969;
 - viii) By-Law No. 28, A By-Law to Regulate Closing of Barber Shops, enacted March 20, 1969;
 - ix) By-Law No. 29, A By-Law To License Bicycles, enacted February 20, 1969;
 - x) By-Law No. 31, A By-Law Relating To the Early Closing of Certain Retail Establishments in the Town of Newcastle, enacted December 1963;
 - xi) By-Law No. 32, A By-Law to Regulate Closing of Hairdressing Establishments, enacted March 20, 1969

- xii) By-Law No. 34, A By-Law in Respect to the Sale and Use of Fire Works and Fire Crackers, enacted August 21, 1969;
 - xiii) By-Law No. 38, A By-Law Relating to the Establishment and Use of Parking Meter, enacted March 20, 1969 and all amendments thereto;
 - xiv) By-Law No. 42, Newcastle Recreation and Leisure Services, enacted March 19, 1992
 - xv) By-Law No. 47, A By-Law to Approve a Certain Contract Between Her Majesty the Queen, the Town of Chatham and the Town of Newcastle, enacted March 17, 1972
 - xvi) By-Law No. 50, A By-Law Prohibiting the Use of Skateboards, Roller Blades & Roller Skates, enacted July 22, 1993; and

3. The following By-Laws of the former Village of Douglastown are hereby repealed:
- i) By-Law No. 30, A By-Law of the Municipality of Douglastown Respecting a Curfew, enacted June 6, 1978;
 - ii) By-Law No. 39, A By-Law Respecting the Village of Douglastown Recreation Commission, enacted August 3, 1982; and all amendments thereto;
 - iii) By-Law No. 45, A By-Law To Define in the Village of Douglastown a Central Area for the Purpose of Accessing Funds Under the Community Improvement Program of the New Brunswick Department of Municipalities, Culture and Housing, enacted February 11, 1992.
4. The following By-Laws of the former Village of Loggieville are hereby repealed:
- i) By-Law No. 22, A By-Law of the Municipality of Loggieville Respecting a Curfew, enacted September 3, 1981; and
 - ii) By-Law No. 49, A By-Law to Define in the Village of Loggieville a Central Area for the Purpose of Accessing Funds Under the Community Improvement Program of the New Brunswick Department of Municipalities, Culture and Housing, enacted April 29, 1992.
5. The following By-Law of the former Village of Nelson-Miramichi are hereby repealed:
- i) By-Law No. 28, A By-Law Respecting the Village of Nelson-Miramichi Recreation Commission, enacted December 12, 1984;
 - ii) By-Law No. 39, A By-Law to Define in the Village of Nelson-Miramichi a Central Area for the Purpose of Accessing Funds Under the Community Improvement Program of the New Brunswick Department of Municipalities, Culture and Housing, enacted March 11, 1992.
6. This By-Law shall come into effect on the date of third reading by title and enacting thereof.
