

BY-LAW NO. 52-1

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 52,
A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF MIRAMICHI
RESPECTING WATER AND SEWERAGE SYSTEMS AND RATES**

The Council of the City of Miramichi, under authority vested in it under the Municipalities Act, enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" of By-Law No. 52, A By-Law of the City of Miramichi Respecting Water and Sewerage Systems and Rates are hereby repealed and replaced by Schedule "A-1" and Schedule "B-1" attached hereto.
2. Section 1. Sub section (9) is amended by adding the following after "right-of-way": "and the tenants of all residences owned by Retirement Miramichi Inc."
3. This By-Law shall be deemed to come into effect on the first day of January 2000.

Schedule "A-1"

Schedule of Water Rates

1.0 There shall be a charge for all customers whose property receives City water as follows:

- (a) Customers whose consumption of City water is not metered shall pay a quarterly rate of \$56.00,
- (b) Customers with meters shall pay a quarterly fee of \$20.00, or \$0.69 per cubic meter of water received as determined by the meter plus a quarterly surcharge related to the size of serviced customer's private water service pipe, whichever is the greater. The applicable surcharge to each customer shall be determined as follows:

Size of private water service pipe	Quarterly surcharge
15 mm	9.95
18 mm	18.77
25 mm	30.33
40 mm	49.01
50 mm	100.15
75 mm	105.40
100 mm	110.93
150 mm	930.22
200 mm	1300.00
250+ mm	1400.00

2.0 All customers owning property with access to City water who choose not to access said City water and to operate a private water well system, shall pay a quarterly rate of \$56.00

3.0 Hydrants

When a person requests the City to use a hydrant, an administration charge of \$200.00 shall be paid in advance of each use, in addition to consumption charges of \$0.69 per cubic meter.

4.0 Ships

When a person requests water for a ship at port, the cost to said person will be \$3.00 per cubic meter, plus the cost of any overtime for City personnel which is required to comply with said request.

5.0 Others

All other requests for City water will be evaluated by the Director who may determine the terms upon which said water may be provided and the cost of said water to the person making the request. Unless provided for otherwise in this By-Law, there shall be no obligation on the Director to approve of any request for usage of City water by any person.

Schedule "B-1"

Schedule of Sanitary Sewerage Charges

1.0 There shall be a charge for all customers whose property receives City sewage disposal services as follows:

a) Customers receiving City water whose consumption of City water is measured by a meter shall pay a quarterly fee of \$20.00, or \$0.89 per cubic metre of City water received by the customer as determined by the meter, plus a quarterly surcharge according to the size of the customers private water service pipe. The applicable surcharge to each customer shall be determined as follows:

Size of private water service pipe	Quarterly surcharge
15 mm	9.42
18 mm	18.22
25 mm	29.72
40 mm	48.32
50 mm	99.24
75 mm	103.60
100 mm	108.73
150 mm	927.09
200 mm	1200.00
250+ mm	1300.00

(b) Customers receiving City water whose consumption of City water is not measured by a meter shall pay a rate of \$69.50 per quarter.

(c) Customers with access to City water who choose not to utilize said access and to operate a private water well system, shall pay a rate of \$69.50 per quarter.

(4) Customers whose property does not have access to City water shall pay a rate of \$69.50 per quarter.

2.0 Customers owning property with access to City sewage disposal services, who choose not to utilize or access said service and to operate any other form of sewage disposal system shall pay a rate of \$69.50 per quarter.
