

BY-LAW NO. 8-1

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 8,
A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF MIRAMICHI
RESPECTING ANIMAL CONTROL**

The Council of the City of **Miramichi**, under the authority vested in it by the Municipalities Act, enacts as follows:

1. Section 6 SEIZING AND IMPOUNDING

Section 6 subsection 8 is repealed and replaced with

6. (8) A Judge of the Provincial Court of New Brunswick, to whom a complaint has been made alleging that a dog has bitten or attempted to bite a person, may summon the owner of the dog to appear and to show cause why the dog should not be destroyed and may, if from the evidence produced it appears that the dog has bitten or attempted to bite a person, make an order directing:
- (a) that the dog be destroyed; or
 - (b) that the owner of the dog keep the animal under control.

This By-Law shall come into effect on the date of enactment thereof.
