

Mission Statement

To preserve and promote the sport of Mountain Biking in all it's facets.

SUMMARY

The mountain bike trails at French Fort Cove Miramichi, are trail-bike/cross country trails. Please be aware several are multi-use trails. There is ample parking at the playground/main entrance on Route 8 - King George Highway, beside the Chrysler/Jeep and Kawasaki dealers. The permanent map by the tool shed is the TRAILHEAD #1; please do not ride through the park by the Canteen and Playground.

There is a fantastic mix of terrain and scenery, the trails are very rarely wet and consist primarily of tight windy single track. There is about 20Km of single track complimented by another 10-15K of power lines, NB Trail and ATV trails. Riding season stretches from the late April to the first snowfall usually early in December.

WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

Weekly group rides: Meet at tool shed FFC parking lot by playground.

Sunday 1PM intermediate ride 12-16Kms

Tuesday 7PM beginner ride 5-9Kms

Wednesday 7PM intermediate ride 12-16Kms

Thursday 7PM Ladies only ride, length dependant on riders & turnout.

Evening rides slightly earlier in autumn.

MMBC is a group of local riders dedicated to caring for and creating a place for people to enjoy mountain biking in Miramichi. Our aim is to protect land access for recreational cyclists, promote fun events or competitions and maintain safe trails.

We strive to make mountain biking attractive to people of all ages and abilities.

Our membership is entirely voluntary as is our trail work. Funding for maintenance projects, mapping and even this brochure is raised solely through volunteer efforts and annual membership dues. If you are interested in joining our club (mountain biker or not) all you have to do is fill out a simple membership form and pay a small annual fee (typically \$20). You can rest assured all monies collected go to good use buying or renting tools, acquiring materials and promoting the sport. Two meetings per year are held and financial reports are given.

Please follow the rules of the trail:

- 1. Ride open trails only**
- 2. Leave no trace**
- 3. Control your bicycle**
- 4. Always yield trail**
- 5. Never scare animals**
- 6. Plan ahead**

A helmet is required and a bell is courteous.
