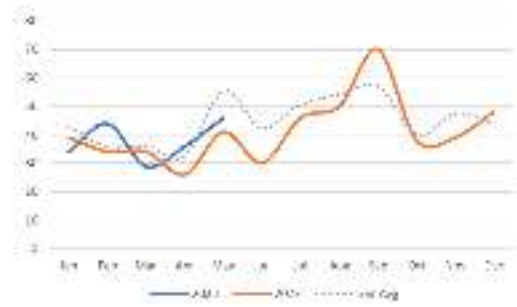




Miramichi Fire Department Monthly Activity Report May 2023
