RECREATIONAL SKATING & SHINNY HOCKEY GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. All patrons will be screened upon entry and contact tracing information will be collected.
- 2. All users will be required to sanitize their hands at our station upon entry to the facility and are encouraged to bring their own alcohol- based hand sanitizers.
- 3. Admittance to the facility will be limited to 15 minutes before and after the designated activity time. There will be no early admittance to the facility.
- 4. Non-medical face masks are required for entry and are to be worn at all times in the facility except when on the ice.
- 5. No re-entry into the facility will be permitted during scheduled activities.
- 6. Foot traffic signage posted on the floor and walls of the arena and lobby will direct patrons to and from their designated areas.
- 7. Maximum of 30 participants for public skating. Maximum of 22 participants for shinny hockey including 2 goalies. Entry will be on a first come first served basis.
- 8. While on arena premises, physical distancing of a minimum of 6'/2m separation will be maintained in common areas.
- 9. Spectator seating will be based on 3'/1m physical distancing with continuous use of mask.
- 10. No food/drink permitted in arenas with exception of participant water bottles.
- 11. Participants will have limited access to dressing rooms and are asked to arrive as "ready for their activity" as possible. Showers will not be accessible.
- 12. Staff will be on duty patrolling the facility and educating patrons on physical distancing and other COVID-19 concerns.
- 13. There will be enhanced cleaning and disinfecting protocols in place.

RECREATIONAL SKATING:

Patrons will be asked to skate in a counter- clockwise pattern.

Skate aids will be sanitized and available for those wishing to use them. When finished, we ask that patrons remove them off the ice surface to the designated sanitizing area for the next user.

The session will run with patrons being asked to adhere to physical distancing unless members of the same household

SHINNY HOCKEY:

During game play, teams can play up to 5 on 5.

The session will run with patrons being asked to adhere to physical distancing measures in mind.

Only 5 players permitted on one bench at a time physically distanced. Absolutely no spitting.
