- c) Update on Multiplex Project from Mayor Lordon The following update was provided: the City has recently been advised by the Province to modify the city's plan for the multiplex project to incorporate a phased approach to development. There has been a significant change to the Integrated Bilateral Agreement for Federal and Provincial funding for municipal infrastructure projects and now it is possible for municipalities to access up to 40% federal dollars without a provincial contribution. The City will be issuing a Request for Proposal for an Owner's Engineer to engage outside expertise to begin exploring options for phased approach to the Project. A new centralized energy efficient recreation facility built with federal and provincial funding support continues to be the least expensive future option for Miramichi taxpayers and will also provide the best possible quality of life and quality of recreation facilities for all Miramichiers.
